How does play teach the child about themselves and the world? Development, social learning and self-understanding for the young child all unfold in the experiences of play. Play is a powerful clinical tool when providers are informed of the typical progression of play in pre-verbal children. We will outline the typical development of play in children birth to five years old and examine how play supports social emotional development. By providing participants a foundational understanding of typical social and developmental play, attendees can better understand play that steps outside of normal expectations. Finally, we will look at how providers can use play as a clinical tool for children delayed in social emotional functioning due to trauma or neglect.
